Little bus back on Purple Wave due to non-payment

Start of School enrollment includes 12 Pre-K, 31 elementary, Junior High 12, High School 17.

Additional Items included staff changes between buildings for SPED and the continued need for substitute teachers.

Phone replacement needed - Cloud phone service by Nextech presented - 3 phones in Damar, 4 in Palco. Discussion of other VOIP phones, Internet phones, or visiting with other districts on equipment/services they have or have not been successful with.
